See if the Rear Parking Sensors are working via the Dashboard Display?

Answer

Reverse Selected - guide appears on dashboard display



2 Feet to go - 2 Beep - warning beep going - radio/cd muted



1 Foot clear - obstruction off side rear corner - constant tone



ZOOM +

[/shadowbox] **You can't really rely on these** as you should be looking over your shoulder to see if there is any obstruction and not at the on-board display.

However the dashboard display will show how close you are to the vehicle behind if you have the uprated display screen fitted to VTR+ and higher spec models

When reverse is selected the dash board shows the outline of a car. When you get to within a metre of an obstruction the sound system starts to emit a 'Beep' and mutes the radio/cd if turned on.

The closer you get to an obstruction the faster the beep until you're within about 1 foot when it turns continuous

You should **STOP** then!
